Time and place

7th of June 2025

Participants of the Competition	Individual participants and teams (4 participants, of which no more than 3 are from the Masters group) in the discipline "The running wild boar 35 m" (SK-35).
Registration of participants	 advance application via info@purnavumuiza.lv or by filling out the application form https://ej.uz/pm-cup or on the SASA website (www.sasa.lv) and by paying the participation fee by the 6th of June 05:00 p.m. (40 EUR) on the day of the competition until 9:30 a.m. (50 EUR)
Participation Fee	 complex shooting: By applying and paying in advance: EUR 50. Paying on the day of the competition: EUR 60. Separately – for shooting types: "The running wild boar 35 m" (SK-35) EUR 20; Sporting EUR 25; Game shooting with a rifle EUR 25 (all amounts include VAT). Juniors (until 20 years old), get a 50% discount on the participation fee. Upon payment of the participation fee, each participant gets 1 coupon for the main prize draw. The prize draw will take place after honouring the winners at the end of the competition day. Should the winning coupon's holder not be in attendance at the time of the draw, the coupon is excluded from further participation. ATTENTION!

Those participants who wish to do so have the opportunity to complete the three basic series offsets in the SK-35 discipline on **Friday**, **6**th **of June**, applying for their start time by the **6**th of June by calling 29363936 (Vilnis). See the table of starting times at www.sasa.lv – "Purnavu Manor Cup 2024", section "Regulation".

The starting time for one participant who completes 10 shots is 5 minutes.

On the day of the competition, 7th of June, the participants of the SK-35 three main heats will sign up in the table of starting times by themselves at the shooting ranges. It is not allowed to correct, cross-out or change entries. By not showing up for shooting, the corresponding participant ends their participation in the SK-35 competition.

!!! Participants who have not registered, received a participant number and signed for compliance with safety rules are not allowed to start the competition.

Programme

Shooting exercises

The competition takes place in the following types of shooting:

- shooting a "running wild boar, 35 m" with a smoothbore weapon (SK-35):
 3 basic series of 10 shots + 1 series for the best 8 in the final
- sporting: 1 series Game Compak of 25 targets + 1 series A traps of 25 targets
- game shooting with a rifle:
 - o shooting with a hunting rifle in a "standing" position, leaning on a loose log, target "doe" at a distance of 100 m, 5 shots in 5 minutes;

- shooting with a hunting rifle in a "prone" position, holding the front part of the weapon, leaning on elbows, target – "the sitting fox" at a distance of 100 m, 5 shots in <u>5 minutes</u>;
- shooting with a hunting rifle in a <u>"standing" position</u>, leaning on a buried pole, target –
 "chamois" at a distance of 100 m, 5 shots in 5 minutes;
- o shooting with a hunting rifle in a <u>"standing" position</u> without support, target **"wild boar"** at a distance of 100 m, 5 shots in <u>5 minutes</u>.

Weapons and ammunition

Smoothbore weapons, rifles and scopes complying with the Latvian hunting regulations. Silencers are allowed.

It is prohibited to use:

- weapons with their straps not removed,
- carbines with a calibre less than .222 Rem.; cartridges with percussion caps,
- round-bore bullets;
- o optical scopes with two independently adjustable sighting poles.
- Use of gloves is not allowed in the rifle discipline.

Judging and awarding

In the individual competition

in each discipline, the 1st-3rd place winners are awarded with prizes, medals and diplomas:

- o **in shooting a "running wild boar 35 m"** (SK-35) by summing up the total score of the 3 basic series and the final;
- in sporting by summing up the total score of the Game Compak and A-trap series;
- o **in the SK-35 shooting discipline** the 1st–3rd place winners are additionally awarded in the competition of teams, juniors and amateur groups;
- o **in hunting with a rifle** one series in compliance with F.I.T.A.S.C regulations;
- in complex shooting by summing up the places obtained by the participants in 3 types of shooting.

In the case of equal results for the prize places:

- o For SK-35, additional shooting is performed (2 shots per participant until the winner is determined);
- For Game Compak + A trap, in the case of equal results for 1st–3rd places, re-shooting is performed. For the rest of the participants the place is determined according to the results of the A trap series. If the results are equal, then the participants get a split place!
- o For complex shooting, the best shots "10" are counted. If these shots are of equal count, then participants re-shoot a standing wild boar from the shoulder at a 100 m distance, with each shooter having two shots until the winner is determined.
- In the case of equal results for the total score, the place is determined by the place obtained in the SK-35 series.

The total prize pool is EUR 10,000.

Promotion Award: A EUR 100 gift card for the participant, who has achieved the best result in the discipline: hunting shooting with a rifle, shooting with **Norma** ammunition.

Among the participants of the competition and all interested parties who shopped at the "Purnavu Muiža" tent (1 coupon = purchase worth EUR 20), there will be a raffle for 10 useful and valuable prizes, incl. Mauser M25 Extreme



Additional competition:

SUPER-HUNTER OF "MĀRKULĪČI"

Participants: any participant who has paid a participation fee of EUR 3 for participating in this discipline. Number of exercise shots – unlimited, each subsequent try is EUR 2.

Course of the competition: shooters compete in shooting with a smoothbore gun and with cartridges charged with 1 bullet shooting plates positioned on racks (Ø 11 cm) or a target (Ø 11 cm) at a distance of 35 m, 42 m and 50 m. Shooting takes place in 7 sub-rounds. If the target is missed with the first shot, extra shots are allowed, which will be taken into account when determining the places acquired by the participants. Number of extra shots is limited. If, in one sub-round, having completed the allowed number of shots, the shooter misses the plate, the participant shall withdraw from the game.

Judging and Awarding:

The judging is performed by the total points for the best discipline.

1st–3rd place winners are awarded with diplomas and cash prizes.

When determining the winners, in the case of equal results, shooting shall be repeated until the first miss at a distance of 50 m.

"THE RUNNING WILD BOAR 17.5 M" (SK-17.5)

Participants: any participant who has paid a participation fee of EUR 3 for participating in this discipline. Number of exercise shots – unlimited, each subsequent try is EUR 3.

Course of the competition: shooters compete in shooting, using a pneumatic gun provided by the shooting range, or by using their own pneumatic gun with 4.5 mm calibre and maximum power of 12 J. Scope – optical scope or open sights. Number of shots – 10.

Judging and Awarding:

The judging is performed by the total points for the best discipline.

1st-3rd place winners are awarded with diplomas and cash prizes.

When determining the winners, in the case of equal results, shooting shall be repeated with two shots until a winner is determined.
